

Lesson Plan for Week of April 16th - April 20th, 2018 Morghan Weekly, 4 year olds

Daily Activities: Free Play, Pledge of Allegiance, Select Daily Helper, Calendar, Centers, Craft or Small Group Activity, Snack, Gym, Music/Story/Chapel/Video.

Themes: Expose children to a wide variety of concepts, ideas, and areas of interest.

Reading Stories/Singing Songs: Encourages language development, literacy, and promotes imagination.

Circle Time: Whole group activity in which the children learn new concepts and share ideas.

Centers: Designed for children’s discovery, use of their imaginations, and learning through play.

Craft: Promotes children’s creativity and development of fine motor skills: cutting, gluing, painting, drawing.

Small Group/Individualized Instruction: Provides the teacher with the opportunity to enhance children’s learning by engaging in one-on-one instruction.

Gym: Children participate in organized games to learn teamwork and free play to develop gross motor skills.
