Lesson Plan for Week of May 7th - May 11th, 2018 Morghan Weekly, 4 year olds

Daily Activities: Free Play, Pledge of Allegiance, Select Daily Helper, Calendar, Centers, Craft or Small Group Activity, Snack, Gym, Music/Story/Chapel/Video.

Themes: Expose children to a wide variety of concepts, ideas, and areas of interest.
